To ensure everyone has a great holiday please consider the following tips. You're here to have a fun, relaxing holiday. And so is everyone else.

- Be friendly to your neighbours. It makes a huge difference to just say hello.
- Don't walk through people's sites. Try to stick to the roads and walkways where possible.
- Always wear a helmet while riding a bike in the park and ensure your children are aware of the traffic conditions.
- If you're in the dog-friendly area, always make sure your dog is under control. Not everyone is an animal lover.
- Park your car on your own caravan site.
- Clean up after yourself. Use the mops and buckets in showers to help us keep the place clean.
- Please either dispose of your rubbish in the bins provided or take your rubbish away with you when you leave. Please also recycle what you can.
- Monitor how much noise is coming from your campsite. This applies to music and loud TV.
- Follow the park rules available on the park website.
- Your kids are your responsibility. As Crosby, Stills, Nash and Young sang, *Teach your children well.*

There are park rules to help guide decent behaviour and assist management across three parks at Anglesea, Lorne and Torquay.

We understand each park is different and there are often individual circumstances that need to be discussed.

PARK RULES

The following is a helping hand covering some of the basics.

In a nutshell, what's changed since last July?

- All funds are reinvested into the park, community and coastline.
- No day fees for visitors
- Twelve Month Permit Holders (TMPs) can now stay a total of 180 days a year and 59 days consecutively.
- We have decreased the cost of the electricity supply charge.
- Caravans can stay on site after 30 years, subject to minimum compliance standards.
- Permits cannot be transferred. A waiting list process will apply. Please discuss with park management.
- Caravan sale process has changed. Vans are independently valued.
- The policy in relation to dogs in off peak periods has been changed. Dogs will now only be allowed in the dog friendly area during periods designated by management.
- You can have tents/gazebos provided they fit on your site and approved by park management. Must be dismantled when site is unoccupied.

What's the same?

- It remains a safe, family-friendly park – and we're looking to make it better.
- All cabins, equipment and infrastructure has remained.
- Permits are renewed annually.
- Visitors still need to register at the office.
- We will trial wristbands to monitor pool use.
- Six people are allowed on each site, but if you have an exceptional circumstance we can discuss.
- One car. Second car by management approval. Anglesea will be busy over summer with less street parking. If you can, we suggest leaving your second car at home.
