### Dog & Animal Policy

#### Sites

- Dogs are permitted in our Dog Friendly sites from – February 1 to December 15 (excluding Easter, Labour Day weekend and Melbourne Cup weekend and other dates as may be notified).
- No more than two (2) dogs can be on a site.
- Dogs must **always be on a lead** under the control of a person who can manage the dog.
- Dogs are not allowed near camp kitchens, laundries, BBQ areas, children's playgrounds, pool or the oval area.
- Owners must not allow dogs to enter other camp sites.
- Dog owners must clean up after their dogs immediately.
- Dogs must be kept under control at all times. Excessive barking will not be tolerated.
- Dogs must not be left unattended.
- At night, dogs must be tied up or corralled in a suitable enclosure to prevent escape. If a dog is found wandering, the owner will be requested to leave the park immediately.
- No exceptions to these conditions will apply to any camper for any reason.

#### Cabins

- Dogs are only permitted in our designated dog friendly cabins. **#37 & #38** from – February 1 to December 15 (excluding Easter, Labour Day weekend and Melbourne Cup weekend and other dates as may be notified).
- No more than one dog can be in a cabin.
- Dogs must **always be on a lead** under the control of a person who can manage the dog.
- Dog owners must clean up after their dogs immediately.
- Dogs must be kept under control at all times. Excessive barking will not be tolerated.
- Dogs must not be left unattended.
- No exceptions to these conditions will apply to any camper for any reason.
- Dogs are not allowed near camp kitchens, laundries, BBQ areas, children's playgrounds, pool or the oval area.

#### Guide Dogs & Companion Dogs

- There are no restrictions to access for guide dogs or companion dogs at any time of the year.
- Customers have to provide proof, in advance, that the dog is a certified guide / companion dog.



- Customers should speak to site management to arrange the best access / location (subject to availability) to assist with access and egress through our parks.
- Dogs must always be on a lead under the control of a person who can manage the dog.
- Dogs must not be allowed to run free within the parks.
- Owners must not allow the dog to enter other camp sites.
- Dog owners must clean up after their dogs immediately.
- Dogs must be kept under control at all times. Excessive barking will not be tolerated.
- Dogs must not be left unattended.
- At night, dogs must be tied up or corralled in a suitable enclosure to prevent escape. If a dog is found wandering, the owner will be requested to leave the park immediately.
- No exceptions to these conditions will apply to any camper for any reason.

### **Dangerous and Menacing Dogs**

- The Domestic Animals Regulation 2015 in Victoria requires that all dog owners of declared dangerous dogs, declared menacing dogs and restricted breed dogs must comply with all requirements of the Act.
- Any dog that has been declared as dangerous or menacing must NOT be brought into the caravan park.

### **Cats**

- Are never allowed in our parks.
- Any customer who brings a cat to our parks will be asked to leave immediately.
